LEED promotes a whole-building approach to sustainability by recognizing performance in five key areas of human and environmental health: sustainable site development, water savings, energy efficiency, materials selection, and indoor environmental quality.” www.usgbc.com

Please note the following for LEED information related to the use of SPEC MIX masonry mortars and grouts from PCI (Elburn, Illinois).

- Each SPEC MIX package from PCI has a 5% Pre-Consumer recycled content.
- 100 % of the aggregate (2,300 #) is extracted and manufactured locally.
- 100% of the raw materials “Harvest / Extraction Sites” are within 500 miles of this project.
- This project is within 500 miles of the finished product manufacturing origin in Elburn, IL.
- This product does qualify for “Regional Materials Credit”.
- Raw material extraction locations from Elburn:
 - Portland Cement - 300 miles
 - Hydrated Lime - 160 miles
 - Aggregate - 3 miles
